### **Know the Context**

A leading project and process management software company in Germany sought to enhance its platform with built-in analytics.

The platform already helped teams manage workflows and collaboration; now users needed real-time insight into performance and progress.

The vision was a unified, intuitive reporting experience where clients could monitor projects and tasks inside the same environment where they manage them.







# **Teams Were Acting Late**

Although the platform generated extensive data, users struggled to turn it into clarity.

Reports were delayed, spreadsheets conflicted, and decision-making lagged behind reality.

- Disconnected, manual reporting limited cross-project visibility
- Hours lost consolidating data from multiple sources
- No real-time insight into progress or bottlenecks
- Reactive rather than proactive performance management

# **Our Solution**

Cedars BC approached the challenge as a data clarity design problem.




- Aligning every visual to those real decision moments.
